The Stop TB Partnership, the World Health Organization and the Global Fund have jointly published "Priorities in Operational Research to Improve Tuberculosis Care and Control." The document, available [here](#), seeks to shed new light on how TB policies and practices can be improved and how new tools for TB can be introduced in ways that deliver maximum benefits.

The Stop TB Partnership, the World Health Organization and the TB Technical Assistance Mechanism (TBTEAM) have jointly released "Guidance to Develop Global Fund Round 11 Proposal for Tuberculosis Control." The document, which can be downloaded [here](#), provides guidance on, among other things, issues specific to submission of a TB proposal, and minimum requirements with respect to what should be included in the proposal.
